Job Summary

Under the direction of the Chair of the Division of Pulmonary Medicine ICU, this position reports to the Cook County Health & Hospitals System (CCHHS) Pulmonary Department and Cook County Department of Public Health (CCDPH) to provide Ambulatory Pulmonary care including Tuberculosis (TB). Works in conjunction with other members of the Pulmonary and TB care teams.

This position is exempt from Career Service under the CCHHS Personnel Rules.

Typical Duties

- Serves as a consultant to clinicians and ancillary personnel in the TB program for the management of routine and complex TB cases.
- Provides outpatient consultations in asthma and pulmonary clinics.
- Considers the role of cultural, social, and behavioral factors in the accessibility, availability, acceptability and delivery of public health services.
- Refers patients as needed to other clinical or social services.
- Applies established principles for management of pulmonary disease, TB prevention and control using activities and resources that include screening, referral and patient evaluation.
- Applies the technical skills necessary to complete work in a timely and efficient manner.
