What is JJCC?

Cook County Health's (CCH) Juvenile Justice Care Coordination (JJCC) team works to support justice involved youth in navigating their care across systems and providers, connecting youth to CCH and community based services, and addressing other areas of need related to social determinants of health.

Referrals come from various sources, including youth and family requests, Juvenile Probation, the State's Attorney Office, Cook County's Juvenile Temporary Detention Center, the Illinois Department of Juvenile Justice, law enforcement, identified medical homes, and community providers.

Youth engage in screening and assessment to allow for coordination of services in the community to address identified needs, meet with their JJCC team for regular case management

calls, and participate in Individual Care Team meetings to insure effective communication between referring parties, families, and providers.

The goal of care coordination is to reduce barriers that interfere with the ability to interface with community based providers through the use of education and supportive services and linking referred youth to behavioral health and other community based programs (mentoring, vocational programs).

JJCC also works to assist families of justice involved youth with enrollment in Medicaid and other benefits, and meet with youth and families in the community, in their homes, and at identified provider locations to best aid in successful utilization of the health system.

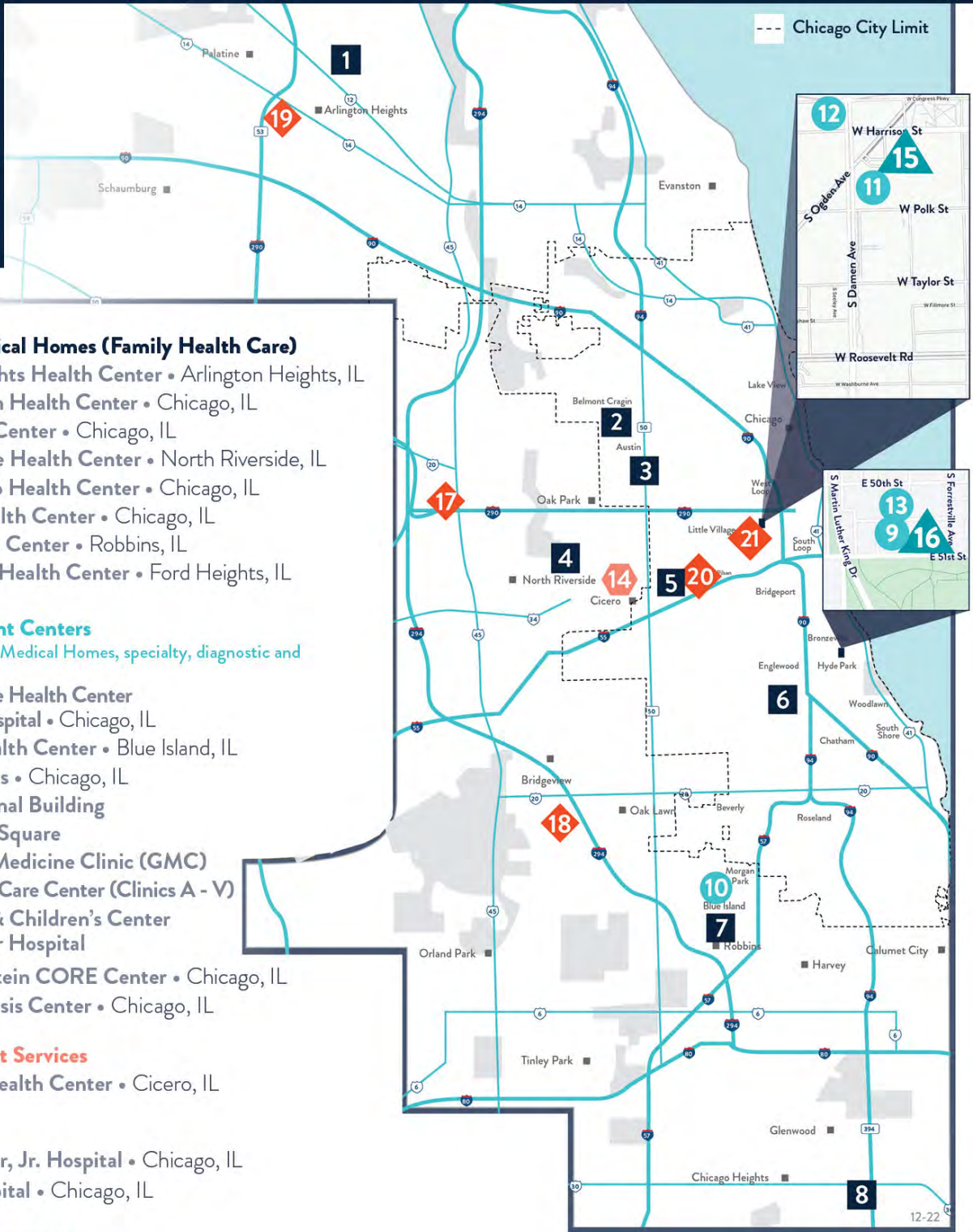

¿Qué es JJCC?

El equipo de Coordinación de Médica en el Centro de Justicia Juvenil (JJCC) de Cook County Health (CCH) trabaja para ayudar a los jóvenes con problemas de la justicia a navegar su cuidado médico a través de sistemas y proveedores, conectando a los jóvenes con servicios proveídos por el CCH y agencias comunitarias, y abordando otras áreas de necesidad relacionadas con los determinantes sociales de la salud. .

Los referidos vienen de varias fuentes, incluyendo las solicitudes de los jóvenes y familias, Juvenile Probation (Libertad Condicional Juvenil), la Oficina del Fiscal del Estado, el Centro de Detención Temporal Juvenil del Condado de Cook, el Departamento de Justicia Juvenil de Illinois, las agencias del cumplimiento de la ley, hogares médicos y proveedores comunitarios.

Los jóvenes participan en evaluaciones y exámenes para permitir la coordinación de servicios en la

comunidad para dirigir las necesidades identificadas, reunirse con su equipo del JJCC para llamadas regulares de administración de casos y participar en reuniones del Equipo de Cuidado Individual para asegurar una comunicación efectiva entre las partes que hacen los referidos, las familias y los proveedores.

El objetivo de la coordinación médica es reducir las barreras que interfieren con la capacidad de interactuar con los proveedores comunitarios mediante el uso de educación y servicios de apoyo y vincular a los jóvenes referidos con la salud del comportamiento y otros programas comunitarios (programas vocacionales y mentores).

El JJCC también trabaja para ayudar a las familias de jóvenes involucrados en la justicia con la inscripción en Medicaid y otros beneficios, y se reúne con jóvenes y familias en la comunidad, en sus hogares y en ubicaciones de proveedores identificados para ayudar en la utilización exitosa del sistema de salud.

The JJCC team works to connect youth and families to a variety of providers and community resources. We aim to connect our members with supports to address all of their goals. As such, we coordinate care with a variety of community based partners to address a range of service needs, including:

- Mental health counseling
- Psychotropic medications
- Substance use
- Trauma therapy
- Mentoring
- Work force development
- Educational supports
- Primary care connections
- Recreational activities

We believe every youth and every family has their own unique recipe for success. Through regular case calls to our members, care team meetings with community partners and the member's support team, and individualized care plans, the JJCC team helps every family find the right fit.

Who and How to Refer?

JJCC serves justice involved youth and families who are at risk for increased involvement with multiple systems (juvenile justice, child welfare, behavioral health, etc.). Youth who are appropriate for referral are residents of Cook County, between the ages of 10 and 21 years old, who meet at least 1 of the following criteria:

- Recent inpatient hospitalization or assessment by SASS
- Current or historical psychotropic medications
- Identified need for outpatient counseling to address symptoms of mental health issues, substance use, or trauma symptoms
- Previous mental health or substance use diagnosis

Nuestro objetivo es conectar a nuestros miembros con el apoyo necesario para abordar todos sus objetivos. Como tal, coordinamos el cuidado con una variedad de socios comunitarios para abordar una variedad de necesidades de servicio, que incluyen:

¿A quién y cómo referir?

El JJCC atiende a jóvenes y familias involucrados en la justicia que están en riesgo de una mayor participación en múltiples sistemas (justicia juvenil, bienestar infantil, salud del comportamiento, etc.). Los jóvenes que son apropiados para ser referidos son residentes del Condado de Cook, entre las edades de 10 y 21 años, que cumplen al menos 1 de los siguientes criterios:

- Hospitalización reciente o evaluación por SASS
- Medicamentos psicotrópicos actuales o históricos
- Necesidad identificada de asesoramiento ambulatorio para abordar los síntomas de problemas de salud mental, uso de sustancias o síntomas de trauma
- Diagnóstico previo de salud mental o uso de sustancias

They perform these stories for the community and facilitate discussions to create change in themselves and their audience. The program ultimately prepares them for meaningful education and/or career-oriented employment.

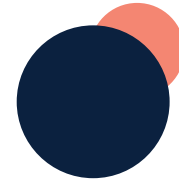

DENTAL & ORAL HEALTH

Why is Oral Health Care Important?

Oral health care is care that focuses on the “health” of your teeth, bones, gums and tissues in your mouth. It is important to have regular checkups by the dentist whether you are a child or adult, have natural teeth or dentures, cavities or none. As partners in your health care, we work together to ensure you receive the best treatment for good oral health.

Baby teeth are important and adult teeth are meant to last a lifetime. By taking good care of your teeth and gums, you can protect them for years to come.

We offer diagnostic and preventive services including: oral exams, cleanings and X-rays.

Basic Dental Services

Oral hygiene instruction, fillings, cleanings, extractions, dentures, partials and scalings

Exclusions

Cosmetic dentistry, implants and orthodontia are not covered benefits nor provided services.

Emergency Services

If you have a dental emergency, and you are a patient of record, you should call your primary care dentist. If you are new to our clinics, you will have to access our clinic to be eligible for emergency care. The clinics open each morning at 8:30 a.m. There are limited emergency slots available.

Expectations

Expect to receive dental care that meets generally accepted standards. Expect to be treated with respect at all times.

We strive to deliver the best diagnosis and treatment that dentistry has to offer. Your first appointment at any of our clinics will be with a dentist who will:

- Review your medical and dental history, and evaluate your oral health
- Take necessary dental X-rays
- Have a discussion about your oral health concerns and needs
- Introduce you to staff that will review policies and procedures

- To schedule an appointment with your primary care dentist for a dental evaluation
- To arrive on time for your appointments and to call 24 hours in advance if you need to cancel

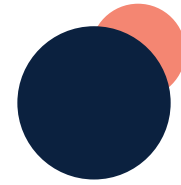
