### Health Professionals Scholarship **\$20,000**

The Health Professionals Scholarship provides scholarships to medical students and students in graduate-level clinical and behavioral health academic programs. Students are eligible for an award of \$20,000.

### Allied Health Scholarship **\$10,000**

The Allied Health Scholarship provides awards to individuals pursuing allied health careers such as: nursing, behavioral health, and students in select qualified certification programs. Students are eligible for an award of \$10,000.
