PRIOR CONTRACT HISTORY:

On 10/27/2017, the CCH Board of Directors approved contract number H17-25-114 in the amount of \$3,085,500.00 for a thirty-six (36) month period from 12/01/2017 thru 11/30/2020. The CCH Board of Directors approved requests on 08/30/2019, 10/25/2019, 07/31/2020, 01/29/2021, 05/28/2021, 07/30/2021 and 10/29/2021 respectively to increase the contract by \$1,700,000.00, \$537,000.00, \$650,000.00, \$1,709,334.11, \$5,740,000.00, \$3,500,000.00 and \$12,562,000.00. On 03/01/2020, the Office of Supply Chain Management approved a request to increase the contract by \$120,000.00 on behalf of Stroger Hospital. On 10/29/2021, the CCH Board of Directors approved a request to extend contract thru 02/28/2022. On 01/28/2022, the CCH Board of Directors approved a request to increase the contract in an amount not to exceed \$28,335,010.37 and to extend the contract thru 11/30/2022. On 06/24/2022, CCH Board of Directors approved a request to increase contract in an amount not to exceed \$149,000.00. On 7/29/2022, the CCH Board of Directors approved a request to fill vacancies for Respiratory, Operations and Support Services in an amount not to exceed \$1,757,360.00, as needed, for the remainder of the contract period thru 11/30/2022.

NEW PROPOSAL JUSTIFICATION:

This request will add staffing resources to coordinate the medical response to meet the health needs of new resident asylum seekers from Central and South America. This will include Medical Intake Assessment, Follow up Primary Care & Specialty Care, Sick Visits and Dental Screenings for Pediatrics.

TERMS OF REQUEST:

This is a request to amend extend and increase contract number H17-25-114 in an amount not to exceed \$3,513,600.00, as needed, for a four (4) month period from 12/01/2022 thru 03/31/2023.

PRIOR CONTRACT HISTORY:

On 09/29/2017, the CCH Board of Directors approved contract number H17-25-102 in an amount not to exceed \$24,065,632.14 for a thirty-six (36) month period from 07/01/2017 thru 06/30/2020. On 07/27/2018, the CCH Board of Directors approved a request to add Palliative Care services required by CCH and increase the contract in an amount not to exceed \$200,348.00. On 07/01/2020, the Office of Supply Chain Management executed a request to amend Pediatric Care service rates agreeing to use third year billing rates and extend the contract thru 12/31/2020. On various occasions, the Office of Supply Chain Management executed requests to extend the contract thru 10/07/2022.

NEW PROPOSAL JUSTIFICATION:

This request is to amend Part IV of the Master Agreement referencing the provision of clinical services by Rush. Each physician and other licensed employee will continue to provide direct patient care, perform procedures, and develop collaborative partnerships and initiatives. Rush will also provide test interpretation, promote research initiatives, clinical trial opportunities, perform various administrative duties as required, and educate medical students, residents, and fellows. Each exhibit of the contract defines the statement of work, associated fees, key performance indicators and metrics for measuring key performance indicators. Negotiations for a new contract for Clinical Services Agreement is ongoing between the parties.

TERMS OF REQUEST:

This is a request to extend and increase contract number H17-25-102 in an amount not to exceed \$8,355,211.00, as needed, for a twelve (12) month period from 10/08/2022 thru 10/07/2023.
